GENERAL NOTICES

Candidates for Election as Ordinary Members should obtain a nomination form from the Secretary, *Mineralogical Society*, 41 Queen's Gate, London S.W. 7. Candidates must be proposed by two members of the Society, one, at least, of whom shall have personal knowledge of the candidate. There is an entrance fee of one pound (£1) and the annual subscription is two pounds (£2); the latter can be compounded for by a single payment of forty-five pounds (£45).
