

## THE CANADIAN MINERALOGIST AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO CANADIAN MINERALOGY

**THE CANADIAN MINERALOGIST** is published by the Mineralogical Association of Canada. It continues the publication known widely as *Contributions to Canadian Mineralogy* which appeared as parts of the Geological Series of the *University of Toronto Studies* from 1921 until the termination of the *Studies* in 1948, and as parts of *The American Mineralogist* from 1949 to 1955. The publication was actively sponsored by the Walker Mineralogical Club from 1938 to 1948 and copies of most parts of the first five volumes are available as noted below. The first number of *The Canadian Mineralogist*, volume 6, part 1, continues the numbering system but did not appear until 1957; no publication appeared in 1956. The cost of publication of volume 6 has been partially met by generous annual grants from the Geological Survey of Canada.

The journal will publish papers in the fields of crystallography, geochemistry, mineralogy, petrology and allied sciences in either English or French. Manuscripts should be typewritten, double-spaced, preferably on letter size paper  $8\frac{1}{2} \times 11$  inches. Illustrations in the form of black-line drawings or glossy prints of black and white photographs should be designed to permit reduction to  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7''$  maximum size. Legends for the illustrations may be typewritten on separate sheets. Preferably an original and one carbon copy may be submitted to Professor L. G. Berry, Editor, Miller Hall, Queen's University, Kingston, Ontario, at any time. Fifty reprints without covers are provided each author free; additional copies will be furnished at cost if ordered at the time the galley proof is returned.

The journal is issued once a year and is sent to all members of the Mineralogical Association of Canada. Membership in the Association is subject to the approval of the executive committee.

**CONTRIBUTIONS TO CANADIAN MINERALOGY** appeared as non-consecutive numbers of the *Geological Series* of the *University of Toronto Studies*. The 26 numbers have been grouped into volumes 1-4 as outlined below.

Except for seven numbers, 16 (1923), 17 (1924), 20 (1925), 22 (1926), 27 (1928), 28 (1929), and 47 (1942), which are exhausted, all the numbers of the series are obtainable at \$1.50 each. The available numbers and dates are as follows:

Seven numbers of *Contributions to Canadian Mineralogy*, constituting volume 5, were printed as one part of *The American Mineralogist* each year from 1949 to 1955. These parts, noted in detail below, were sent to all subscribers to *The American Mineralogist* and will therefore be found in library files of that journal. Separate copies were also sent to all members of the Walker Mineralogical Club. Back numbers of all issues of *Contributions to Canadian Mineralogy* (volumes 1 to 5), except seven noted above, may be purchased from the Secretary, Walker Mineralogical Club, 100 Queen's Park, Toronto 5, Canada. The 26 issues which constitute volumes 1 to 4 may also be obtained on microfilm from the same address.
