Some years ago I examined some crystals of aragonite for Strontium. Obtaining unweighable traces I tested in the blowpipe flame, and was not a little surprised to find the coloration was green. In the spectroscope I got from the original substance the lines of both barium and strontium. Is this a common experience? The mineral was from near Wookey Hole, Somerset, whence I brought it myself.
