### **Biennial Grant for Research in Crystallography**

***Edward H. Kraus Crystallographic Research Fund***

**and the**

***Jewell J. Glass Memorial Legacy***

This grant is awarded to defray the expenses of research in crystallography. Proposed studies of direct relevance to mineralogy and petrology will be given preference. The only restriction on eligibility for the grant is that an applicant must have reached his or her 25th birthday but not have yet reached his or her 36th birthday as of the date the grant is awarded. There are no restrictions on how the grant is to be spent, other than the requirement that it be used in support of the crystallographic research of the recipient. The grant, in the amount of \$1500, will be given in 1984 and in even-numbered years thereafter. The recipient will be selected by the MSA Council at the annual fall meeting in 1983. The choice will be based on recommendations from a committee appointed by the President of the Society.
